

"How Districts Conduct Competitions" 2017 AFCD Annual Meeting Breakout Session


Poster Contests - Speech Contests - Envirothons - Land Judging

- Determine which contest/contests best fit District's Goals and Objectives (your District can effectively compete in one or all areas).
- If Coordinator is a District staff member, be sure to acquire "buy in" from Board of Supervisors to create a positive environment for successful implementation of program.
- Determine, with Board approval, whether it's appropriate to invite contestants from counties without SWC Districts to participate.
- Secure copies of all rules and regulations related to the competition at all levels so District winners will be able to move forward to Area, State and National levels, if appropriate (without potential disqualification).
- Determine financial commitment necessary to adequately support the contest or program and what resources can be secured to meet needs.
- Research appropriate timetable for each competition (contests with area, state or national levels have very specific dates for participation in every level above District level).
- Determine potential participants for executing competition (this may include your local school system, 4-H and FFA programs, Extension programs, Farm Bureau, others).
- Select cooperating partners for the program (this may be a team of people with expertise in the specific subject area, e.g.: School art teachers for the poster contest; speech teachers for the speech contest; ag programs for land judging; science teachers for Envirothon programs, etc.). Cooperating partners can be brought together as a group or work individually within their own area.
- Begin developing a timetable for project thresholds (contact with school programs, media promotion, etc.). Make sure that you have allowed ample time to conduct the program effectively, and if necessary, set the program out a year to allow it to be done successfully).

- Where appropriate, select contest sites, judges, etc. well in advance, so a last minute crisis can be averted, if possible. When selecting judges make sure they have the expertise in the field, e.g.: judges for the speech contest should not be District Supervisors or staff and should include someone with public speaking knowledge, someone with subject knowledge, etc.
- Send out invitational letters to potential participating groups (this can include associations, organizations, schools, etc.).
- BE INCLUSIVE Make sure you offer participation opportunities to all public, private, parochial and home school groups within your District.
- COMMUNICATE COMMUNICATE COMMUNICATE It's essential to keep everyone well informed about all aspects of the competitions at all times. Communication can be via email, phone, mail, face book, personal meeting, etc. Make sure that you have at least one "live meeting" with involved adults (teachers, coordinators, etc.) which may be on the phone or in person meeting. DON'T RELY ON EMAILS FOR YOUR FIRST CONTACT.
- MAKE STUDENTS FEEL POSITIVE FOR THE EFFORTS THEY'VE PUT IN TO
 PARTICIPATE IN THE COMPETITION. A WINNER IS NOT JUST THE HIGHEST
 SCORING INDIVIDUAL, BUT RATHER EVERYONE WHO DEVELOPS SKILLS
 AND ABILITIES AS A RESULT OF BEING INVOLVED. Examples: Certificates
 with each student's poster on them for all entries, gift bags for students in
 events where possible, recognition at their school or group meeting.
- PUBLICIZE EVENT RESULTS through media (newspapers, radio, television, face book, websites, etc.)
- EXPRESS THANKS!! Show your gratitude to judges, contestants, supporters and others at every opportunity. A note of thanks to a judge or teacher can be a powerful tool when it comes to future participation.
- KEEP GOOD RECORDS to make the next event even easier.
- TAKE A DEEP BREATH AND REPEAT!!






